1. Grief and disappointment. In 1 Samuel 1, we see Hannah turning to God in her grief, being honest with Him, and trusting Him before things have changed.
2. Living in the gap between pain and promise. This is hard, requiring faith, but this is what life is supposed to be like.
3. Taking the first step. Sometimes, we have to make a move in response to God before He acts. Fear keeps us stuck but God has more for us if we will trust Him.

Questions for discussion:

- What were some of your highlights from the weekend? Social moments, nature and the weather, the teaching from Phil and Sarah, meeting with God in worship, hearing God speak, etc.
- Which of the three teaching sessions felt particularly significant to you? What was God saying to you and how do you need to respond?
- Which of these felt particularly significant for King's? What do think our response to this should be?
- Phil and Sarah repeatedly insisted that they believe God is speaking more than we hear, that any of us can experience His leading more if we attend to Him. How could you become more aware of God's leading?
- Did God give you new or renewed faith for something at the weekend? What can you do to continue fanning it into flame and act on it?
